

RESOLUTION 80- 4

LIMITED MORTGAGE ASSISTANCE DESIGNATION

1 WHEREAS, the California Housing Finance Agency (the "Agency")  
2 desires to enter into a program of financing assistance within  
3 the City of Woodland (the  
"Locality"); and

4 WHEREAS, as required by Sections 51304 and 51308 of the  
5 Health and Safety Code, the Agency finds that:

- 6 ● It is an area (1) where deterioration has not progressed  
7 to the stage where there is a substantial number of resi-  
8 dential structures which do not conform to rehabilitation  
9 standards, or (2) where a program of concentrated code  
10 enforcement has been conducted previously.
- 11 ● There is a recent history of mortgage deficiency in the  
12 area.
- 13 ● Agency activity in the area is likely to prevent or arrest  
14 deterioration in the area.
- 15 ● Agency activity in the area is economically feasible.
- 16 ● Agency activity in the area will inure primarily to the  
17 benefit of persons and families of low and moderate income.
- 18 ● The area was selected by the legislative body, after an  
19 approved citizen participation process which meets the  
20 legislative requirements.
- 21 ● The local agency in which the area is located has given  
22 substantial assurances acceptable to the Agency that it  
23 will provide those supporting neighborhood public improve-  
24 ments and services determined appropriate by the Agency;  
25 and

19 WHEREAS, the Locality has given evidence of compliance with  
20 California Environmental Qualities Act, and the Agency has re-  
viewed submitted documents and found them to be adequate; and

21 WHEREAS, the local agency has agreed that all contracts let  
22 for management, construction, or rehabilitation shall be open to  
23 all regardless of race, sex, marital status, color, religion,  
national origin, or ancestry, and pursuant to an approved affirma-  
24 tive action program.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Agency hereby designates  
25 the City of Woodland  
mortgage assistance area(s) for the purpose of

26 New Construction Only

27 for a period of one year, commencing with the execution of an  
agreement between the locality and the Agency; such execution to

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take place no more than 90 days from this date; and the Agency staff is authorized to file a Notice of Determination or other material that may be required.
