RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A FINAL LOAN COMMITMENT

WHEREAS, the California Housing Finance Agency (the "Agency") staff has reviewed a loan application from Donald S. Kavanagh, Jr., under the Housing Assistance Trust loan program for Twin Pine Apartment and has recommended to the Board of Directors (the "Board") that such loan be approved; and

WHEREAS, the Lending Committee has reviewed that loan application and concurs in the recommendation of the staff; and

WHEREAS, the Board has approved an initial loan commitment Resolution 90-27 on September 13, 1990 for such development; and

WHEREAS, based upon the recommendation of staff and the Lending Committee, the Board has determined that a final loan commitment be made for such development.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board:

1. The Executive Director, or in his absence, the Deputy Director or Director of Programs of the Agency is hereby authorized to transmit a final commitment letter, subject to the recommended terms and conditions set forth in the CHFA staff report dated April 10, 1991, in relation to a multifamily housing development described as follows:

"Material modifications" as used herein means


