RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A FINAL LOAN COMMITMENT

WHEREAS, the California Housing Finance Agency (the "Agency") staff has reviewed a loan application from Case Avenue Associates, a California Limited Partnership, under the Agency's Tax Exempt Risk Sharing Affordable Mortgage Loan Program for The Promenade and has recommended to the Board of Directors (the "Board") that such loan be approved; and

WHEREAS, Section 1.150-2 of the Treasury Regulations requires the Issuer to declare its reasonable official intent to reimburse prior expenditures for the Project with proceeds of a subsequent borrowing; and

WHEREAS, based upon the recommendation of staff, the Board has determined that a final loan commitment be made for such development.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board:

1. The Executive Director, or in his/her absence, the Deputy Director or Director of Programs of the Agency is hereby authorized to transmit a final commitment letter, subject to the recommended terms and conditions set forth in the CHFA staff report dated October 26, 1995, in relation to a multifamily housing development described as follows:



"Material modifications" as used herein means modifications which, in the discretion of the Executive Director, or in his/her absence, the Deputy Director or

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Director of Programs of the Agency, change the legal, financial or public purpose aspects of this commitment in a substantial way.
