| 18       | long term housing recovery solutions for the families impacted by the recent natural disasters as    |
| 19       | well as to consider solutions to mitigate the housing impacts of future events;                      |

| 21       | WHEREAS, in light of the State's need to respond to the recent natural disasters with                |
| 22       | long term housing recovery solutions, the Agency desires to assist non-first time homebuyers of      |
| 23       | low and moderate income impacted in a disaster-declared county.                                      |
| 24       | NOW THEREFORE BE IT RECOVERS 1. I. B I ARL   |
| 25       | NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors (the "Board") of the                        |
| 26       | California Housing Finance Agency as follows:  |
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| 28       | 1. The Agency may provide home purchase assistance to a non-first time homebuyer                     |
| 29       | of low and moderate income who has lost an owner-occupied home in a natural disaster as              |
| 30       | declared by the Governor.  |
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| 32       | 2. As soon as practicable, the Agency is directed to make necessary programmatic                     |
| 33       | changes to implement the foregoing under terms and conditions approved by the Executive              |
| 34       | Director.  |
