MyHome Loan Amount Cap Waived for CalHFA FHA 203(h) Borrowers

Effective May 17, 2021 CalHFA will waive the \$11,000 cap on borrowers using the CalHFA FHA loan with FHA section 203(h). This bulletin supersedes Program Bulletin 2018-10, all other terms remain the same. The updated MyHome Program Handbook will be available on CalHFA's Loan Programs website starting on the announced effective date.

Summary of MyHome Loan Amount Limits

First Mortgage	Maximum MyHome Loan Amount
 CalHFA Conventional CalPLUS Conventional CalHFA USDA 	 Loan amount not to exceed the LESSER of: \$11,000 or 3.00% of the sales price or appraised value, whichever is less
CalHFA FHACalPLUS FHA	 Loan amount not to exceed the LESSER of: \$11,000 or 3.50% of the sales price or appraised value, whichever is less
The following categories are <u>NOT</u> subject to the \$11,000 loan amount cap.	
Eligible Borrower(s) School Employees Fire Department Employe Eligible Loan Types CalHFA VA First Mortgage CalHFA FHA 203(h) 	 Manufactured Housing Properties Single Family homes with Accessory
