MyHome Loan Amount Cap to Increase to \$15,000

CalHFA is increasing the loan amount cap on the MyHome Assistance Program to \$15,000 effective for loans reserved on or after August 16, 2021. This cap increase supersedes the previous cap announced in Program Bulletin 2021-01. All other loan amount limits for the MyHome Assistance Program remain the same. The updated MyHome Program Handbook will be available on <u>CalHFA's Loan Programs website</u> starting on the announced effective date.

Summary of MyHome Loan Amount Limits

First Mortgage	Maximum MyHome Loan Amount
 CalHFA Conventional CalPLUS Conventional CalHFA USDA 	 Loan amount not to exceed the LESSER of: \$15,000 or 3.00% of the sales price or appraised value, whichever is less.
CalHFA FHACalPLUS FHA	 Loan amount not to exceed the LESSER of: \$15,000 or 3.50% of the sales price or appraised value, whichever is less.
The following categories are <u>NOT</u> subject to the \$15,000 loan amount cap.

¹School Employees are defined as teachers, administrators, school district employees and staff members working for any <u>California public school</u> (Pre/TK - 12) or public-school district, which includes charter schools and county/continuation schools. Additional documentation required to determine eligibility.

²Fire Department Employees are defined as firefighters, administrators and all other state, federal, local or tribal fire department employees. Additional documentation required to determine eligibility.

Note: Loans reserved prior to the effective date of August 16, 2021 are subject to the current MyHome \$11,000 cap; no exceptions.

Reminder: CalHFA strongly encourages lenders to use the Closing Doc Wizard in <u>MAS</u> during the doc drawing process. The Closing Doc Wizard ensures the closing docs are being drawn correctly with the applicable fields auto-populated.
